- Labor Costs in South Korea -

Labor costs are an important factor in establishing and operating a business in Korea. Wages in Korean companies often vary depending on several factors that usually remain vague to foreigners. We collected some hard data regarding the labor costs in Korea.

Tables and data presented in this overview focus on the salary level in Korea and tackle both, the private and the public sector, which may give readers an interesting perspective about the general labor market situation.

This report contains the updated information for 2022, which has been acquired in the course of a research at local institutions, ministries, and other Korean sources such as job portals.

As all salaries in this report will be given in Korean won (KRW), here are the exchange rate as of 24.02.2022 for an easy calculation:

- 1 USD 1,201.50 KRW
- 1 EUR 1,350.01 KRW

As of **2022**, an amount of **9,160 KRW** has been set as the official **minimum wage per hour in South Korea**, a rise by approximately 5.1% comparing to the previous year. It was the smallest-ever annual increase, as the decision-makers took into account economic difficulties facing small-business owners due to the pandemic.

There are also rules applying for teachers who are paid according to Article 32 paragraph 1 sub paragraph 4 of the "Educational Officials Act", and their pay shall not exceed the 14th pay grade. Staff who are paid according to Article 13 paragraph 2 of an "Enforcement Decree of Educational Officials Appointment" shall be appointed as teachers on a part-time basis.
